

Most Improved Cadet – Presented by Supply Officer

- *Cadets attributes have improved
- *Uses acquired knowledge & skill
- *Shown noticeable improvement
- *Continues to Excel
- * 75% attendance or greater

Citizenship Award – Presented by Civilian Instructor/Civilian Volunteer

- *Illustrates the attributes of citizenship
- *Attends all Citizenship parades (Poppy Sales, Remembrance Day, etc)
- *Encourages others to get involved, not just at the squadron but at home, in the community and School
- *80% attendance or greater

Top Aviator Award – Presented by Ground School Instructor

- *Ideally he/she should have obtained a GPS/PPS Scholarship
- *Must be involved in the squadron's aviation program (typical involvement includes helping teach ground school and or aviation classes and assisting with famil flying and participation with the gliding center operations
- *Motivates fellow cadets to become involved in aviation
- *80% attendance or greater

Top Instructors Award – Presented by Training Officer

- *Able to present the material in an interesting manner (use of AMI)
- *Encourages cadets to perform to the best of their abilities
- *A leader and a motivator
- *Always prepared for the assigned lesson
- *Lesson plans are handed in a week prior to lesson
- *Takes an active roll in the progress of their cadets training
- *Affectively uses available resources and materials
- *80% attendance or greater

Top Marksmanship – Presented by Range Safety Officer/Coach

- *Be selected by the Range Safety Officer (RSO)/Range Coach
- *Should have been a member of the marksmanship/biathlon team(s)
- *Participated in a majority of range activities
- *Shows enthusiasm for the marksmanship/biathlon program(s)
- *committed to improving their skills
- *demonstrates sportsmanship conduct in competitive settings
- *Demonstrates leadership in the marksmanship/biathlon program(s)
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Recruit (1st Year Cadet) – Presented by Chief Warrant Officer (WOI)

- *Shows exceptional promise in first year
- *Shows exceptional dedication
- *Has made gallant efforts to attend all cadet activities (Mandatory & compulsory)
- *Adapted to Squadron structure, drill, dress and deportment
- *75% attendance or greater

Outstanding Junior Cadet – Presented by Deputy Commanding Officer

- *Has attained the rank of FCpl (Flight Corporal)
- *Is a model for other cadets (Drill, dress, deportment, conduct, etc)
- *Shows potential as a future leader
- *75% attendance or greater

Outstanding Senior Cadet – Presented by Operations Officer

- *Responsible for the operation of the Squadron
- *Creating and maintaining a high morale and esprit de corp
- *Maintains a high level of discipline and professionalism
- *Has become a true leader
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Overall Cadet – Presented by Commanding Officer

- *Excels in all areas of training
- *Surpasses the expectations of their training level
- *Is a positive influence in helping others achieve their level of training
- *Displays outstanding attributes of leadership and mentorship
- *Individual ability and personal conduct
- *Exemplifies all the aims and values of the Cadet Program
- *Must be considered a WORTHY AMBASSADOR for the squadron
- *80% attendance or greater

Best Dressed Cadet – Presented by _____

- *Exemplary dress
- *Conforms to current cadet dress regulations
- *Brightly Shone boots
- *Consistent model to fellow cadets on how to properly wear the cadet uniform
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Level 1 Cadet

- *Displays outstanding ability in all areas of the level 1 training program
- *Shows competence and confidence in drill and leadership skills
- *Exemplary attendance
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Level 2 Cadet

- *Shows notable ability in their level
- *Outstanding attendance at both parades and other activities
- *Achieves well above cadet standards
- *Eager to learn and willing to put in extra time necessary to reach full potential
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Level 3 Cadet

- *Same as above, and
- *Potential future leader
- *Willing to assist in any way to benefit the squadron
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Level 4 Cadet

- *Outstanding leadership skills
- *Accepts responsibility as a senior cadet
- *Uses their knowledge and skills to further subordinates
- *Shows significant contribution to squadron operations
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Level 5 Cadet (NEW)

- *Excel's in all aspects of the Cadet Program
- *Risen to a level attained only by the most dedicated cadets
- *Knowledge and skills benefit other cadets
- *Ability as a leader contributes to the structure of the squadron
- *75% attendance or greater

Top Leadership Award (NEW)

- *Must be Sergeant or above
- *Ability to lead and inspire
- *Demonstrates the enthusiasm essential to motivate others
- *Leads by example
- *Proven Leadership capabilities
- *Must have attended at least 80% of parades

903 Esprit de Corps Award (NEW) – Donated by Capt C.Wilson

- *Succeeds in spite of all odds
- *Exemplifies the moral of the squadron
- *Works on maintaining excellent spirit
- *Provides highly effective and important informal leadership
- *Is a true optimist
- *Participated as fully as possible during activities
- *Shows a genuine interest in the welfare of his/her fellow cadets
- *80% attendance or greater

Top Flight

*The flight should set the standard for the squadron in the following ways:

- *Attendance – Average percentage over the year
- *Morale and flight interaction
- *Continual improvement throughout the year
- *Effective communication throughout the chain of command

Top Bandsman

- *Must show dedication to band activities
- *Exceptional musical ability
- *Provide leadership to fellow band members
- *Excellent drill, dress and deportment

Charlie Bowen Award (Top Parent Volunteer):

- *80% attendance at all parent meetings
- *Takes initiative and is enthusiastic bringing up new ideas
- *Participates in all fundraising
- *Willing to go the extra mile

Effective Speaking

- *80% Attendance or greater
- *Be within the top three effective speakers at squadron level
- *Ideally he/she would have went to Wing/Provincial Competition
